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GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Is on-campus housing available for transfer students? **PCA&D has a Housing Referral Service which assists students in finding an apartment. PCA&D has a number of Master Lease Agreements which allows students to pay rent through their tuition bill. The Housing Referral Service also assists in connecting students with landlords for additional options as well as roommates through weekly listings in the late spring through early summer. Most apartments are within a 6 block radius of the college allowing for easy accessibility.**

Cost: 1-bdr – approx. \$700-850 per month, 2-bdr – approx. \$800-1,000 per month

2. Full-time tuition: **\$24,250** Part-time tuition: **\$1010 per credit**

3. Scholarship availability for transfer students: **yes**

Can the transfer student with an associate degree normally expect to receive the baccalaureate degree in 2 years? **PCA&D and BCCC currently have a 2+2 transfer articulation agreement for students interested in receiving their BFA in Graphic Design, Illustration and Fine Art. Assessment of the transfer student's transcript will be required for a PCA&D Plan of Study whether they are going through the articulation agreement or a different path.**

TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

1. Best time(s) to apply: **for fall enrollment, we operate on a rolling admissions policy but encourage students to work on completing their application process by April. Deadline(s): July 1st for fall enrollment – December 1st for spring enrollment**
2. What grade point average (4.0 scale) do you consider? **2.5 +** Prefer: **2.5 +**
3. If different averages are required for different curricula, please specify: **N/A**
Do you accept GPA accepted as calculated by previous college or do you re-calculate? **Accept as calculated by previous colleges**
4. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: **60**
5. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? **During the Admissions Process once all college transcripts and course descriptions are received and once the student has been accepted. Upon acceptance a Transfer Credit Evaluation is created and a Plan of Study mapping out a student's time at PCA&D broken down by each semester.**
6. Must SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer students? **No, PCA&D is test optional**
7. Must the H.S. transcript or GED be submitted by the student with an associates degree? **Yes – they must be submitted by all applicants. If a student earned a GED, they must submit this as well as their high school transcript.**

8. Is the transfer student required to have had the same high school courses (e.g. foreign language, math) as entering freshman? **PCA&D does not require any pre- requisite coursework from any applicant – high school or college.**
