1. Is on-campus housing available for transfer students? **A selected number of on-campus spaces are available each semester on a first come, first served basis. University sponsored off-campus housing is also widely available.**
2. Full-time tuition: **\$13K-17K range in-state** Part-time tuition: **\$502 avg. per credit hour in-state** Is evening tuition different? **No**
3. Scholarship availability for transfer students: **Yes, scholarships available if 3.3+ cum GPA. Dual Admissions scholarships also**
4. Can a transfer student with an associate degree normally expect to receive the baccalaureate degree in two years? **Degree completion depends on the degree program.**
5. Can a transfer student complete baccalaureate programs on an evening schedule? **Some programs offer evening courses** If so, in what programs? **Selected Business and Liberal Arts majors; check each School/College for more info**

Transfer Requirements

1. Best time(s) to apply? **Rolling** Deadline(s): **November 1st for Spring, June 1st for Fall**
2. What grade point average (4.0 scale) do you consider? **2.50 minimum** Prefer? **3.00** **GPA alone does not guarantee admission (academic progress and grades trends are important)**
3. If different averages are required for different curricula, please specify: **3.25- Architecture; Tyler requires portfolio; Dance/Music requires audition; Nursing highly selective (not designed for Transfer students), and HIM is competitive (2.8+)**
4. Do you accept GPA as calculated by previous college or do you re-calculate? **We calculate a cumulative GPA if a student is transferring from more than one college.**
5. Maximum number of credits accepted in transfer: **No maximum**
6. When does the applicant learn which credits will be accepted in transfer? **A preliminary evaluation is mailed within two weeks of acceptance.**
7. Must the SAT or ACT scores be submitted by transfer students? **No, if the student has 15+ transferrable college level credits or is 22 years or older.**
8. Must high school transcripts or GED be submitted by students with an associate degree? **Yes**
Without the degree but with 30 credits or more? **Yes** With less than 30 credits? **Yes—required to complete file.**
9. Is the transfer student required to have had the same high school courses (e.g. foreign language, math) as entering freshman? **No**
If yes, can these be satisfied by college courses? Will these courses also be credited toward the baccalaureate?
10. Are D's transferable? **No** With an AA degree? **No** Without an AA degree? **No** Explain.
11. Do you accept Prior Learning Assessment (AP, CLEP, credit by certifications or portfolio, etc.) which may appear on the Bucks transcript? **No (we accept AP if student sends us official score report and has appropriate score; CLEP can be reviewed by Dean later)**

1. Which programs, if any, are closed to transfer students? **University Studies for students transferring 60 credits or more. Nursing is designed for incoming freshman; transfer students can apply with less than 30 credits and 3.5 GPA but that does not guarantee admission.**
