Note 1: These majors are flexible. The B.A. degree requires 9 credits of B.A. Requirement in in Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, Natural Sciences, Quantification, and Foreign Language. Students in these Penn State Abington majors (B.A. and B.S.) also take 15 credits of Electives. All Bucks courses in the Social Science major will fulfill a Penn State requirement for the Major, as Elective, or as B.A. Requirement, depending on the student's Penn State

major. (For the B.A. degree, Penn State requires **Foreign Language** to the 12<sup>th</sup> credit level, Language 202. Penn State Foreign Language courses are 4-credit courses.)

Note 2: Keep track to fulfill Penn State Abington's **General Education requirements** for these majors:

- 6 credits in Arts
- 6 credits in Humanities
- 6 credits in Social and Behavioral Sciences
- 3 credits Health and Physical Activity
- 6 credits in Quantification (with at least 3 credits in Mathematics or Statistics)
- 9 credits in Natural Sciences
- 3 credits in United States Cultures, 3 credits in Other Cultures, *and* 3 credits in International Cultures can double count with the courses listed above (**example: U.S. History= both Humanities and U.S. Cultures requirement; any Western Heritage History = both Humanities and International Cultures requirements; SOCI 120 = Social/Behavioral Sciences and B.A.'s Other Cultures requirement**)

Note 3: Penn State suggests one of the following LITR courses to fulfill the General Education, Humanities, and International Cultures requirement: LITR 205, 206, 234, 254, 255, or 278.

Note 4: Students should consider a Penn State Minor (usually 18 credits, including 6 credits at the 400 level). Sociology, Psychology, and other Minors are available. See a Penn State transfer counselor for details.

Note 5: Students who took COMP 111 prior to July 2015 will receive credit for ENGL202B. After that date students will receive no transfer credit because the course transfers as COMP 110. COMP 111 is under review. Current Bucks CCC students should request permission to *substitute* COMP 114 for COMP 111 to receive credit for ENGL202C, Technical Writing.

Note 6: BCCC suggests students take 9 credits in SOCI, POLI, or GEOG, based on their Penn State major requirements. Contact a Transfer Counselor at Penn State Abington for advice.

Note 7: Penn State suggests one of the following to fulfill General Education, Arts, requirement: COMT 101 or 103; MUSC 101, 105, or 106; VACV 142; VAFA 100, 107, 111, 141, 160, 161, 171, 181, 191, 192, 193, or 194. See Note 2.

Note 8: Penn State suggests one of the following: HLTH 103, 110, 120, or 130. Note that Penn State requires 3 *credits* of Health and Physical Activity.

Note 9: Take any 3- or 4-credit BIOL, CHEM, PHYS, or SCIE.

Note 10: **Additional Policies:** Transferable courses MUST have a grade of **"C" or better**. Developmental and remedial courses are NOT included in transferable credit. Course work from another college or university **must be evaluated separately**. Penn State Abington's degree requires a **minimum 2.0 GPA** for transfer as calculated by Penn State. Before admission, students must complete certain high school courses, including math and foreign language. See [psu.edu/admissions/](http://psu.edu/admissions/).
