Bucks County Community College is offering a transition program for students with a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) who are college-ready and capable. The AACHIEVE! Program (**A**n **A**utism **C**ollege **H**igh School **I**nnovation for **E**ducational and **V**ocational **E**xcellence) is modeled on the PDE/BSE partnership with the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education (PASSHE) Autism Support Initiative for Success Program.

The AACHIEVE! Program at Bucks aims to support students with transition planning upon entering the community college and the transition to a four-year institution. The ultimate goal is to complete college through degree completion and to find employment.
