



Bucks County Community College and Gwynedd Mercy University Dual Admissions Intent Form



Bucks County Community College (Bucks) and Gwynedd Mercy University (GMercyU) enter into this Dual Admissions Agreement so that Bucks students admitted into specified Associate degree programs at Bucks will be admitted into a Bachelor's degree program at GMercyU. The degree programs included in this program are:

- A.A. Business Administration → B.S. Accounting, Business Management (online and accelerated), Finance, Human Resources, Management, and Marketing
- A.S. Biology → B.S. Biology
- A.A. Communication Studies → B.S. Digital Communications
- A.S. Computer Science → B.S. Computer Information Science
- A.S. Cybersecurity → B.S. Computer Information Science
- A.A. Criminal Justice → B.S. Criminal Justice
- A.A. PreK – 4 Early Education → B.S. Early Education, and Early Education & Special Education
- A.A. History → B.A. History
- A.A. Secondary Education History → B.A. History with Secondary Education certification
- A.S. Mathematics → B.S. Mathematics
- A.S. Secondary Education Mathematics → B.S. Mathematics with Secondary Education Certification
- A.S. Medical Lab Technician → B.S. Medical Laboratory Science
- A.A. Psychology: Pre-Professional → B.A./B.S. Psychology, or BS in Applied Psychology (online and accelerated)
- A.A. Social Work → B.S.W. Social Work, or B.A./B.S. Human Services
- A.A. Sports Management → B.S. Sports Management

Bucks students can be accepted on the condition that they:

- Graduate from Bucks with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0. The Accounting, Biology, Computer Information Science, and Education majors require a 3.0 GPA
- Enroll at GMercyU within one year of Bucks graduation
- Do not attend another institution of higher education between the time they graduate from Bucks and enroll at GMercyU
- Complete a "Dual Admissions Intent" form before completing 30 college level credits
- Satisfy all GMercyU admissions requirements, including:
 - Completing a free online application at gmercyu.edu
 - Submitting official copies of all college transcripts from every institution attended. Students are strongly encouraged to send an official copy of their Bucks transcript to GMercyU as soon as possible following the submission of this Dual Admissions Intent Form.

Once Bucks students have satisfied these requirements, they will be eligible for:

- No admissions application fee when using the online application
- An annual academic merit scholarship, provided they graduate from Bucks with a GPA of 2.5 or higher
- A free transcript evaluation Opportunities to meet with GMercyU representatives for assistance in transferring to a bachelor's degree program at GMercyU
- Invitations to relevant programs and open house events
- Priority consideration for institutional, federal, state and other sources of financial aid

You, the student, may void this agreement at any time with written notification to Bucks and GMercyU.
